Thanks for downloading the fall garden planner from www.PintSizeFarm.com.

All the pages can be printed and put into a binder or folder. You can put the pages directly in or, if you are planning on carrying the notebook with you, then put page protectors in your notebook and slide the pages in those. That will keep them from getting wet and/or dirty.

- The cover page has a table where you can outline where your plants are located.
- Print a middle page for every type of plant in your garden.
- The final page has some suggestions for fall plants. There is space for you to add plants that are not on the list, but work well for you. You can also cross out ones that do not work for you.
